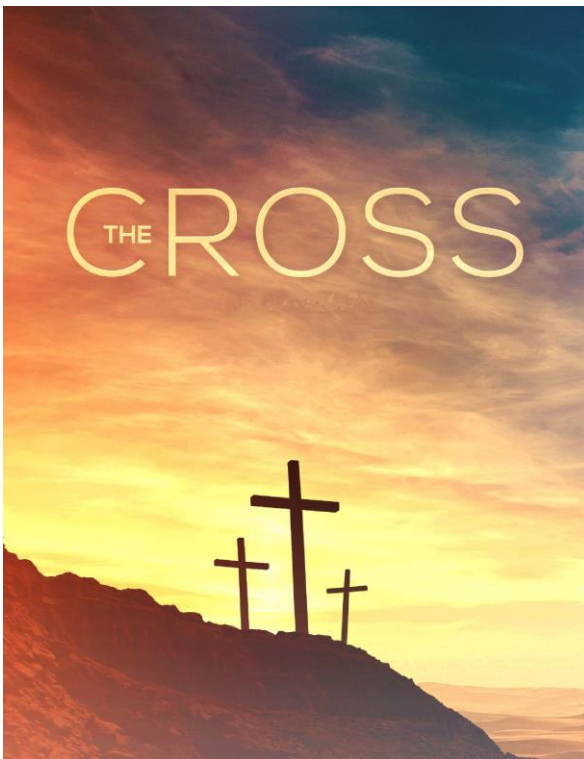

Our transitional housing ministry has continued to grow with the completion of the apartments at 101 Quarterline and the donation of the Mercer House. Hope 101 has become well known in the

community and we did not want to lose that recognition when creating a new 501(C)3 corporation. As of last week, “Hope 101 Ministry, Inc.” is officially a non-profit organization that will encompass all of our transitional housing ministry. To prevent confusion, Anchor Home was chosen as the new name for the house across the street. We will use the names **Mercer Home** (42 Washington St.) and **Anchor Home** (formerly Hope 101) for the “Hope 101 Ministry” houses.
