PASTOR TRANSITION. As we enter the period of Pastor Barb's transition and search for our next pastor we will be keeping our congregation and members informed of the process, with an update provided at our Congregational Meeting on June 25. We welcome your input and support, as follows:

This past year, led by CRT and Leadership, we have confirmed our identity: we are a missional church (Wednesday activities, Hope 101, Matamoros, etc.), with a desire for continued strong preaching and growth – including young families. We will welcome input from anyone in our congregation who has thoughts or suggestions as to how we apply this identity to our search for our next pastor. During this time, they ask for us to sit outside the cabins--assuring the campers stay inside in their beds. Three couples are needed to provide cabin coverage. Would you do this for a night or more? Help is needed on July 6, 7 and 8--you arrive at Camp Henry at 8:30 p.m. and sit outside (watching the stars, etc.) until 11:30 or midnight. Will you help?
